Small Business Energy Saver Program

SEMMA have partnered with SECCCA to host a session discussing the Victorian Government's **Small Business Energy Saver Program** (SBES). This webinar is designed to both aid in economic recovery from COVID-19 hardships, as well as save on energy bills by upgrading to more efficient systems or appliances.

Examples of energy efficient upgrades covered by the SBES rebate include:

- Replacing inefficient electric hot water systems.
- Replacing inefficient gas hot water systems.
- Upgrading to efficient room reverse cycle air-conditioners.
- Installing energy-efficient refrigerator display cabinets.
- Installing energy-efficient fridges and freezers in break rooms/kitchenettes.

Rebates may be able to cover up to 85-95% of the cost (\$2,000 cap).
